



DIRECTIONS

From the M6 take Junction 40. Take the A66 towards Brough. Turn right at the next roundabout onto the A6 towards Shap. Go over Eamont Bridge and turn right at the mini roundabout and onto the B5320 signposted Pooley Bridge and Ullswater. Keep on the road for approximately 2 miles and on entering Tirril village go past the Queens Head Pub. Broad Ing Cottage is on the left hand side as you are leaving the village, turn left into the courtyard at the 30mph limit sign.
